



Caledon Specialist Clinic

Scope of Service

The Caledon Specialist Clinic (the “Clinic”) is a joint venture between Caledon Community Services, the Central West Local Health Integrated Network, Headwaters Health Care Centre and William Osler Health System.

The Caledon Specialist Clinic is committed to providing residents who reside within the Caledon Community with specialty care and other health care programs within their own community. The Clinic’s Coordinator provides coordination of services; receives referrals from local primary care physicians and aids in the scheduling of appointments; coordination of the day-to-day activities; and outreach required to promote the Clinic.

The Clinic is located at 18 King Street East, Unit L9, Bolton and is open Monday to Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. unless a specialist or other program is in the Clinic past that designated time.

The Specialists host clinic days once or twice per month. The Diabetes Program with William Osler Health System runs every Tuesday from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. All specialist services and programs are by referral only from a primary care physician or nurse practitioner and all services provided are covered by OHIP including any Ontario Telemedicine Network (the “OTN”) appointments. There is no fee for any of the above services.

The Clinic is also an Ontario Telemedicine Network site and offers a variety of mental health programs, nephrology and other speciality care programs and education events. All appointments with specialists through OTN are by referral only and are covered by OHIP. The only charge through OTN is for work books for some of the programs or workshops offered through OTN.
