

## Rights and Responsibilities of Persons Served

## As a client of Caledon Community Services, you have the right to:

- Use services if you qualify and they are available.
- Make informed decisions about your care.
- Have a say in who is on your service team.
- Choose your own goals.
- Get a copy of your plan and receive help understanding it.
- Be involved in planning for yourself.
- Know how long you will receive services and when they will end.
- Refuse services if you don't want them.
- Have your privacy respected.
- Know what information is kept about you and where it is stored.
- See your client file or record.
- Be notified as early as possible if an appointment or workshop is changed or canceled.
- Have appointments and workshops start on time.
- Request a review of a decision or file a complaint about your services.
- Be treated with respect.
- Be safe from harm, including theft, bullying, threats, physical violence, or unwanted touching.
- Be protected from neglect.
- Receive services that respect your beliefs, gender identity, sexuality, and culture.

## As a client of Caledon Community Services, you have the responsibility to:

- Understand that verbal or physical abuse toward staff, students, volunteers, or visitors is not allowed.
- Treat other clients, staff, students, volunteers, and visitors with respect.
- Participate in your care plan as much as you are able.
- Recognize that other clients may have more urgent needs at times.
- Be honest about your personal health information.
- Take care of your personal belongings and valuables.
